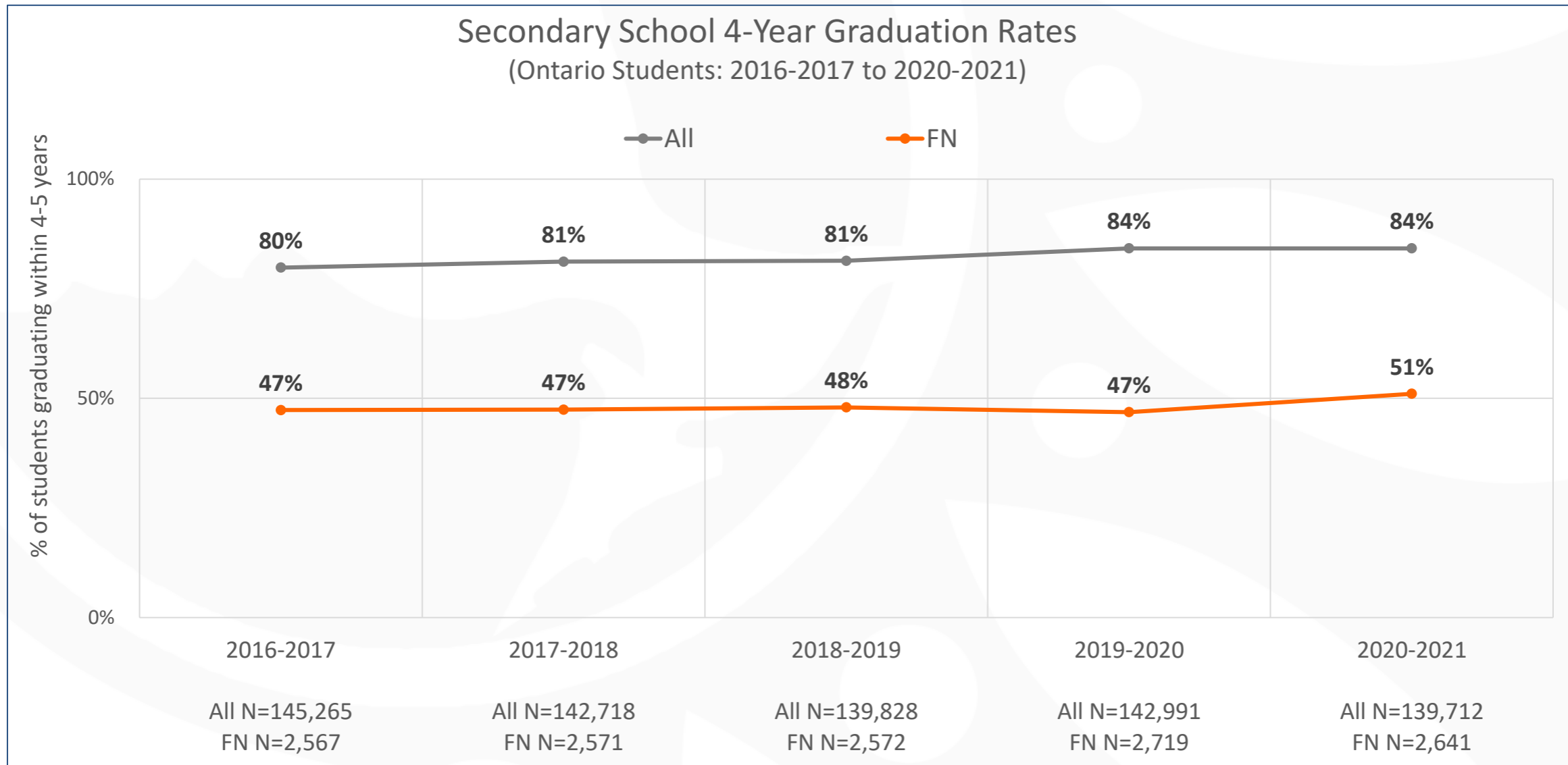

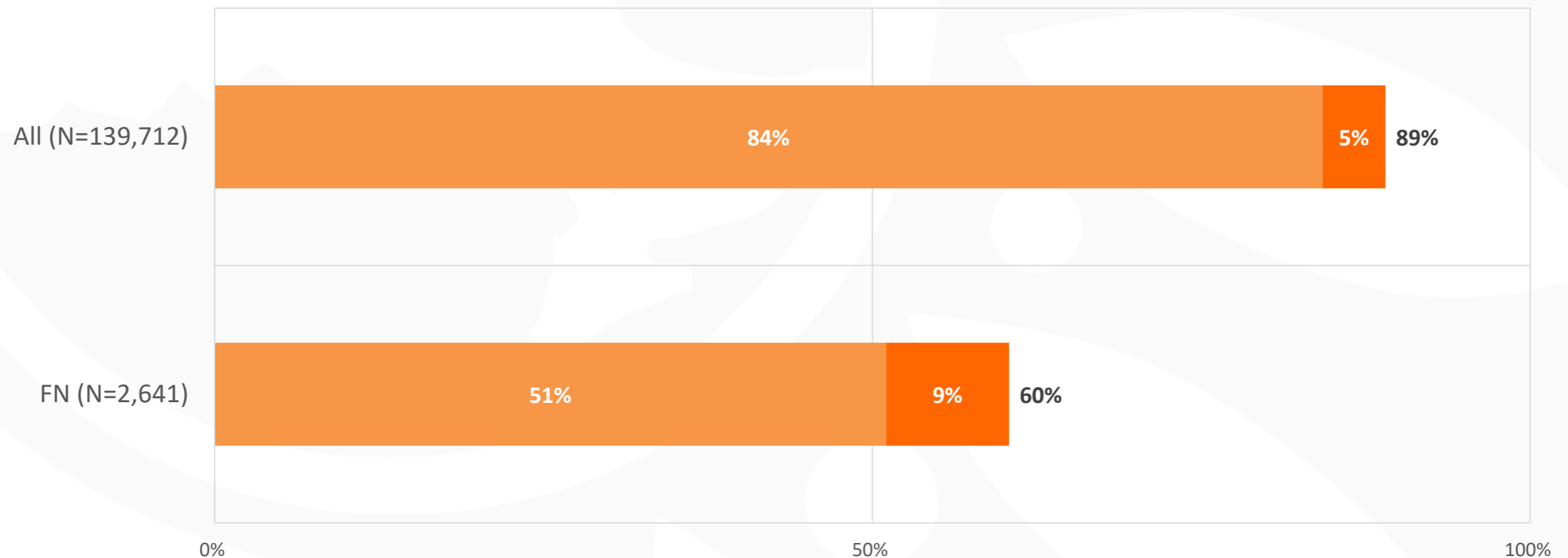

(Ontario Students: 2020-2021)

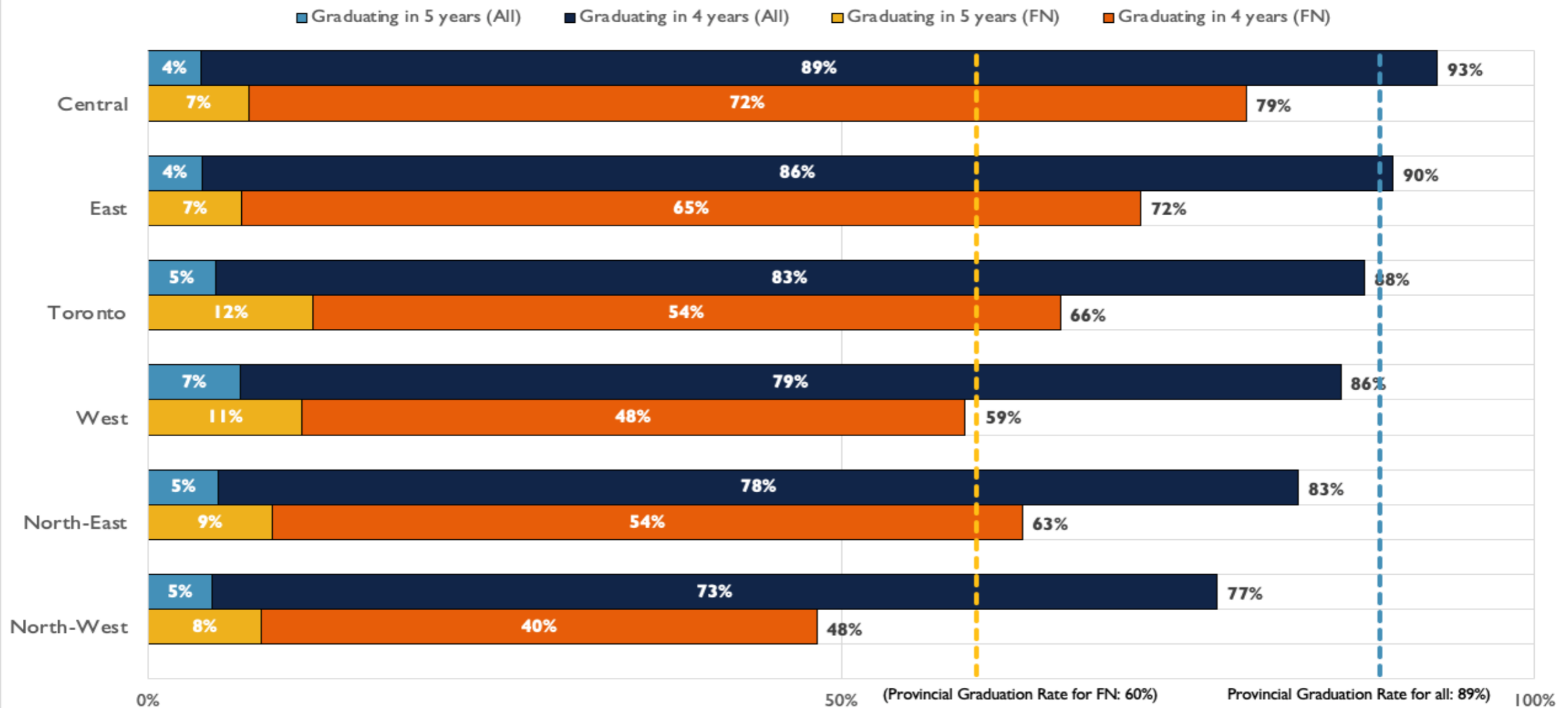
■ % of students graduating in 4 years ■ % of students graduating in 5 years
