## **FNWSC Goal**

A FN-led funding parity plus plus model for a FN distinction-based, FN-controlled and FN-designed education system achieved through a Nation-to-Nation relationship.

This entails an honourable governance approach to Nation-to-Nation relations that includes respectful and shared processes with the intent to negotiate:

- 1) Co-determined legislative response to inherent rights & education jurisdiction.
- 2) Comprehensive funding commitment to full jurisdiction based on equity of outcomes.


Steps taken to get to a Joint Education Technical Table with the Federal Government concerning equity of education outcomes for First Nation learners belonging to our FIrst Nation communities


#### **Three Day Summit**

Bring Nations together, reaffirm collective unity amongst nations, gathering within cultural protocols, to deliberate jurisdiction pathways for negotiation strategy development.









**Model for First Nation involvement in Negotiations**
